Treasurer's Report - Angela Hammond

HGS Treasurer's Report | August 2025

This report provides an overview of the financial status of the Houston Geological Society (HGS) as of the end of August 2025. Note that the 2025-2026 fiscal year budget is yet to be finalized, therefore no graphs are included in the August Report.

Executive Summary:

- HGS Total Equity increased \$39,411 from July 2025 with a decrease in expenses due in large part to a credit of \$22,000 for the Golf Tournament
- Budget We are back up to about 2.5 months of reserves from 1.7 months in July, much better shape, but still less than the desired 3 months of reserves.
- August 2025 Summary: The Investment portfolio continued to steadily increase from July 2025 to August 2025 by ~\$16,251. Revenue increased by \$23,160 from July 2025 to August 2025 due to a decrease in expenses and revenue outweighing the expenses by by almost 8X. Expenses from July 2025 to August 2025 decreased by ~\$35,400, there was no website upgrade expense this month and the credit to the Golf Tournament offset the majority of expenses. Overall, Net Revenue for August 2025 increased \$15,858.
- As stated in last month's report, Student Expo donation and sponsor income <u>has</u> helped offset expenses. Membership renewals went down again from July by about 3X along with publication royalties significantly decreasing from ~\$4,400 in July to \$100 in August. On the flip side, registrations have doubled from July and <u>sponsors</u> income has increased about 6X, mostly due to the Student Expo.

Still in the black, still have 2.5 mos. Expenses down and revenue up.

Membership renewal revenue down.

Motion: Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Bryan moved and Andrea second the Motion. There was no discussion, Vote passed Unanimously.

Only one new Emeritus Status Update this month. Will look into website functionality for new membership applications and if it seems to not be working.

 - c) Patty will get back with them and notify that we typically charge for advertisement and see what they can do.
 - d) Discussion around if we advertise, maybe we can get an in kind/reciprocal advertisement at no cost.

Currently only one person registered for September Dinner.


Great maps below showing where members are located vs. Venues. Trying to give some optionality to members outside of Energy Corridor.


